

## The Skilled Worker Card (CSCS)


To apply for a Skilled Worker CSCS card, an applicant is required to hold one of the following:

- NVQ Level 2 or 3
- City & Guilds Craft/Advanced (and proof of apprenticeship completion if time served)
- Approved Apprenticeship (for example, completion proof of SBATC / NJCBI)

*If you do not have any of the above qualifications but have on the job experience (normally at least one year in the last three) they can apply for a Temporary Experienced Worker card.*

The card is valid for 5 years and can be renewed.

The Skilled Worker Card was introduced to replace Construction Related Occupations (CRO) cards. In response the MPBA has developed the Level 2 NVQ in Modular and Portable Buildings to enable a Skilled Worker to be endorsed for Modular and Portable Buildings, indicating ability to work on carpentry, structure, plumbing and other areas required to install, dismantle and maintain buildings.



### How do I get a Card?

To apply for a CSCS card an applicant will first need to pass the relevant level Health, Safety & Environment Test.

The test is a cost of £19.50. This can be booked online at [www.citb.co.uk/hsandetest](http://www.citb.co.uk/hsandetest) or by calling the test bookings team on 0344 994 4488. Times, dates and venues available for the test will be confirmed at the time of booking.

Once the test has been passed the individual can contact our Helpdesk on 0344 994 4777 to apply. They will need to have a debit/credit card available to make the payment of £30.00. The Customer Co-ordinator will then be able to process and request the card whilst they are on the phone (providing all criteria for the card applied for has been met) this will be sent out the next working day via first class post.
